

## Fall Creek Falls Summer Bible Camp 2024 @ Piney Creek Group Camp

1<sup>st</sup> Week – Senior Week – June 23 – June 28 2<sup>nd</sup> Week – Junior Week – June 30 – July 5

**Summer Bible Camp:** Summer Bible Camp will begin its 66th session this year at Fall Creek Falls State Park. Summer Bible Camp is operated by members of the church of Christ and directed by Mark Cagle of Pikeville, TN, a Deacon at Bethel church of Christ. You may contact Mark at 423-718-1582 or coachcagle@gmail.com. A few facts about camp are listed below.

**Location:** The camp is located in beautiful Fall Creek Falls State Park at the Piney Creek Group Camp (formally known as Youth Camp 2).

**Accommodations:** The cabins are designed to lodge a counselor and seven campers each. The camp only furnishes a bed with a mattress. Campers must furnish bed linen, covers, pillow, towels, and all personal belongings. Cabins at Piney Creek Camp are very rustic and have no heat/air. You may bring fans, but we are not allowed to bring air conditioners.

**Ages:** The ages eligible to attend camp are 10 through 19 years old. Anyone who reaches their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday on or before the date of camp is eligible. **Please do not ask for exceptions.** This camp is open to people of all religious beliefs.

**Cost:** A fee of \$125 will be requested for each camper for each week. T-shirts are included with the fee. This fee covers the cost of operation of the camp. An advance payment of the full amount must accompany each application. In the event of cancellation, the fee will be returned upon request of the applicant, provided the request is made at least one week prior to the camp date. ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY JUNE 15, 2024.

**Health and Safety:** First aid supplies will be available. Children will be under adult supervision at all times – both day and night. We expect campers to be covered by a family insurance plan. Please list your policy name and address on the application.

**Cabin Request:** You MUST accept the counselor assigned to your cabin. Campers may request one cabin mate and this cabin mate must request you as well. Please do not ask for more than one person to be your cabin mate. No request for cabin mates can be guaranteed. Campers may request their parents as counselors if they are serving in that capacity. CAMPERS ARE EXPECTED TO ACCEPT THE ASSIGNMENTS GIVEN THEM WHEN THEY ARRIVE AT CAMP. NO CHANGE REQUESTS PLEASE.

**Camp Activities:** Camp activities include two hours in Bible classes each day besides the devotional periods in the mornings and evenings. Other religious activities include singing and cabin devotionals. Sports activities include the gaga pit, softball, volleyball, basketball, foursquare, corn hole, fishing, hikes, and possibly swimming. Crafts will be available to those who are interested at an additional cost. The camp store will have candy, snacks, and drinks for sale.

**Visitors:** All visitors must check-in with the camp director as soon as you arrive. Sorry, but **NO** overnight visitors will be allowed. Only family members of campers may visit. Visitation is only allowed in the afternoon from 2:30-5:00 pm CST. Campers are not to invite their friends to visit. <u>All visitors are asked to follow the same dress code as</u> <u>campers and counselors</u>.

**Camp Check-Out:** <u>All campers must be checked out of the camp by 1:00 pm CST</u> <u>on Friday of each camp week</u>. Campers are not allowed to leave camp during camp session without prior written permission. Campers must be signed out each week by someone listed on their pick up list.

**Camp Sessions:** *Campers must apply the week of their age group.* The main program will be designed for campers ages 14-19 the first week of camp (June 23 – June 28) and for campers ages 10-13 the second week of camp (June 30 – July 5). You may only register to attend 1 week of camp at this time. You must register the week of your age group unless you have permission from the Camp Director.

**To Make Reservations:** Fill out the registration form and enclose it in an envelope addressed to **SUMMER BIBLE CAMP, 1086 TERRY RD, PIKEVILLE, TN 37367.** Send an application with payment (payable to Summer Bible Camp) to reserve your space. Camp will fill up quickly! NOTE: Camp is often filled by mid-May. *No reservations will be accepted after June 15, 2024.* Applications received after camp is full will be placed on a waiting list. Money will be refunded if no vacancy occurs near the camp date.
